### **PART A :-**

On 15th March 2005 a regular Principal was appointed in our college, receiving a charge from an officiating Principal. New plans and programmes are chalked out and teaching and non teaching staff together assisted to work on strategic plans of the college.

From this session we have joined a group of five colleges known as "**Meghdoot**" which is formed under the leadership of S. K. Porwal college Kampthee, recently. The group is formed to share the ideas activities and enhance the development of the colleges included.

### **PART B :-**

#### **1) Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution**

##### **During the Session 2005-06 :-**

a) To improve English among the students of our college, a meeting of students was held on 18th Jan. 2006 under the guidance of Shri. A.N.Kadbe, HOD (English) and other faculty member of English Department. In this meeting an Executive body of "**English Literary Association**" was formed in which Principal is the chairman of the association. The Head of the Deptt. of English is vice - chairman, a lecturer of English is secretary, two students are joint secretaries and five students are members of the executive body of this association and
