## **ANNUAL QUALITY ASSURANCE REPORT OF INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL**

**Year of the Report :-** 2006 - 2007

**PART A :-** At the beginning of the first session, in the meeting of all teachers new plans and strategies were planned. Work of the different departments was distributed among the teachers. Detail discussion was held about the all sided development of college, different programmes about the college discipline, academic development, cultural development. Employment, cultural development. Employment generation were planned in the meeting.

**PART B :-**

**1) Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution**

**During the Session 2006-07 :-**

a) In this session, Marathi Department of the college inaugurated 'Marathi Literature study club' for the post-graduate students on 12 th October 2006. Shri Chandrakant Wankhede, "Editor of Sakal"

newspaper and Shri. S.M. Dhond were the chief guests of the



function. Teachers and students of U.G. and P.G. level attended the programme. The study club also organized "Kavyatarangini" a kavisammelean on 15 th December 2006. Shri. Vitthal Lanjewar, and eminent poet of the region was the chief guest of for this programme. Students and teachers of U.G. and P.G. level actively participated in this programme. This is the platform, which

give an opportunity to our students to make their literary facet sharp and wide. Department has also started of "Novel Scheme" to provoke the activity of the students. From this session we asked the students to make projects on various topics. High response of the students is recorded.

- b) The department of Commerce has organized a Bank visit programme for the students of commerce. The students visited branch of Bank of India Lakhani, on 12th October 2006 to know more about banking and its management. During the visit the Bank officials demonstrated the actual working of bank. They also introduced the computerised banking system to the students.

The department also organized a lecture on "Personality Development" - Its importance in competitive world. Mr. Shrikant Kulkarni, The district project officer Bhandara was the chief guest of this programme. He focused on various facets of the personality development and also introduced the various government schemes and policies for small scale industries development, to the students.

- c) The students of science faculty which is newly started from the session, visited "Pench National Park (Distt. Nagpur)". The



students collected various species of plants and preserved them and prepared herbarium. They also observed other floras and faunas of the site. Students prepared visit report and submitted to the department which is an essential part of the their curriculum.

- d) The students of Geography department which is also newly started from the session, visited "Markanda" (Dist. Gadchirolli) a place of historical and geographical importance. The objective of this visit was to observe Geographical landscape and collect the more information from the site which is useful their study point of view. Students also noticed that there is so much difference between landform and mountain region among the plain region of the Wainganga river valley. It is also noted that there is close relation of human career and topography.
- e) Department of Music and Sanskrit combinely organized a programme of "Kalidas Day" and "Sanskrit Day" on 19 th August 2006. Prof. Sarojtai Deshmukh of Swawlambi Adhyapak Vidyalaya, Wardha was the chief guest for this programme. Students of Sanskrit department performed a short play "अभिजात शांकुतलम" written by Kalidas. The Chief guest spell bounded all the audience by narrating the variety of sanskrit language and its humourical aspects.
